THE ARK OF COVENANT

Mercy Seat

Most Powerful Blood Covenant
with Each Born Again



Exodus 25:10-22
Hebrew 9:1-28

The Mercy Seat is God's throne of power to show compassion for each man. In that position of love, everyone can benefit His grace because of the shed Blood of the Lamb of God that has been presented. (sprinkled).

1. Difference between Mercy and Grace

Both relate to God's unlimited goodness, but mercy and grace describe two different aspects. In Hebrew, **Mercy** is "rachamim" which is very closely to **Compassion**. Meanwhile Hebrew word for **Grace** is "hesed" which means **Favor**. The Lord can manifest both in the life of His people.

In the **Ark of Covenant**, there are three items: the two stone tablets on which God had written the Ten Commandments, Aaron's rod that bloomed and the golden pot of manna. (Hebrews 9:4) These objects are symbols representing the things of God that man has rejected which made him a rebel, a sinner.

1. The two stone tablets of God's commandments represent the standard rules of consecration, of holiness and of relationship.
2. Aaron's rod that bloomed represents the way of God, the authority of God for the total restoration of man and to direct man in the right way.
3. The golden pot of manna represents God's daily provision.

Because God delights in mercy, He had these items put away in the ark and covered with the mercy seat, which had two protectors' angels cherubim on it. (Hebrews 9:5) And once a year, the high priest

would enter the holy of Holies where the ark was and sprinkle the blood of the animal sacrifice on the mercy seat.. As long as the blood is on the Mercy Seat, there will be Mercy from the Lord.

Today, **Jesus is our High Priest** and He Himself has sprinkled His own blood on the Mercy Seat which is in Heaven—the Throne of Grace. (Hebrews 9:23–26) And because His sacrifice is perfect because He is perfect, we can ask for Mercy and stand before the presence of God because He sees His Son’s blood on the Mercy Seat (Hebrews 8:12, 10:17). This means man rebellion; man’s sin can be paid for. (Colossians 1:14 Galatians 3:13). What each one must do next is to consecrate self to the one that gave His blood for you. Let live for God daily in victory life!

2. Old Covenant / Testament

Leviticus 16:15–16 - The Day of Atonement

¹⁵ “Then he shall kill the goat of the sin offering, which *is* for the people, bring its blood inside the veil, do with that blood as he did **with the blood of the bull, and sprinkle it on the mercy seat and before the mercy seat.** ¹⁶ **So he shall make atonement for the Holy Place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel,** and because of their transgressions, for all their sins; and so he shall do for the tabernacle of meeting which remains among them in the midst of their uncleanness.

6. Prayer Points for Mercy

1. “O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good; for his mercy endured forever.” (1Chro 16:34)

Father, I thank you for you are good and your mercy endures forever. Thank you for making mercy available through the sacrificial Blood of Christ.

2. “You in Your mercy have led forth the people whom You have redeemed; You have guided *them* in Your strength to Your holy habitation.” (Exodus 15:13)

Lord, again I want to thank you for redeeming me by mercy, by the same mercy lead me to dwell in your temple of peace and glory in the name of Jesus Christ.

3. “But showing mercy to thousands generations, to those who love Me and keep My commandment” (Exodus 20:6)

Father, show me more mercy for me to love You more, to serve You and keep Your Word.

4. “But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, ⁵ even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved)” (Ephesians 2:4)

Oh God, You are rich in mercy and kindness, cause me to enjoy and share the abundance of your mercy around me in Jesus name.

5. “Pardon the iniquity of this people, I pray, according to the greatness of Your mercy, just as You have forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now.” (Numbers 14:19)

Oh Lord, pardon my sins by the greatness of your mercy, in Jesus name. Forgive all my weaknesses by reason of the blood of Christ, in Jesus name.

6. “But My mercy shall not depart from him, as I took *it* from Saul, whom I removed from before you.” (2 Samuel 7:15)

Lord, I am the seed of Abraham, and Jesus Your Son is my Savior, may your mercy manifest in my life every day, in Jesus’s name.

7. “Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness! You have relieved me in *my* distress; Have mercy on me, and hear my prayer.” (Psalm 4:1)

Lord, by your mercy deliver me from distress and pains, oh God of my salvation, give me relief of misery, in Jesus’s name.

8. “But as for me, I will come into Your house in the multitude of Your mercy; In fear of You I will worship toward Your holy temple.” (Psalm 5:7)

Lord, I come to you in the multitude and abundance of your mercy, hear my prayer and accept my worship, in Jesus’s name.

9. “Have mercy upon me, for I am weak: O LORD, heal me; for my bones are troubled.” (Ps 6:2)

Lord, have mercy upon me; heal me of sicknesses and diseases and strengthen me by your grace.

10. “Have mercy on me, O LORD! Consider my trouble from those who hate me, You who lift me up from the gates of death.” (Psalm 9:13)

Oh Lord, have mercy upon me and deliver me from all my troubles. Deliver me also from death, Lord, by your mercy, in Jesus’s name.

11. “The leprous lifted up their voices, & said, Jesus, Master, have mercy on us.” (Luke 17:13)

Oh Lord Jesus, have mercy on me. Remember your sacrifice on the cross for me and have mercy upon me. Your blood must not be in vain in my life.

12. “The LORD will perfect that which concerns me; Your mercy, O LORD, endures forever; Do not forsake the works of Your hands. .” (Psalm 138:8)

And now Lord, perfect all that concerns me by your mercy; Lord, do not abandon...in Jesus name.

13. “Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.” (Psalm 23:6)

Father, let your goodness and your mercy be my companion, in Jesus name.

Thank you, Lord, for your mercy. Amen!
